- Include identifiers e.g. name of person taking the photo and state or Province.
- Identify people, Society or glad variety in the photo if known
- Include a brief description for each photo.
- Entries must be received no later than Friday, August 12, 2022.
- Photos taken in 2021 or 2022 are preferred.
- Photos will not be judged and no awards will be given.
