APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Application form must be filled out completely.
2. Application must be received before Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>. Notification of decision will be made by Feb. 15 after the National Conference.
3. Request for continued funding needs to be yearly by way of progress report due Dec. 1 of research year.
4. On completion or termination of project, research findings and a brief for "Glad World" must be submitted.
5. All paper work is to be sent to chairperson.

6. The North American Gladiolus Council (NAGC) does not pay for indirect costs for the

research and checks will be issued as an “unrestricted gift” for the approved research.
