

## Glad Show Design Rules 2019

1. Gladiolus must predominate in the design.
  2. Foliage, other flowers and a minimum of dried, painted or treated material may be used, if desired.
  3. No artificial flowers or foliage permitted.
  4. Accessories, figurines and bases permitted in all classes.
  5. Wall pockets and pedestals are permitted. **However**, all materials are to be provided by the entrant, including boards, supports, structures, etc.
- \*Notify the show chairperson by 8 pm the day before the design show to accommodate for the allotted space.
6. A legend card is to accompany each design.

### NOTE TIMES BELOW:

\*Designers pick up flowers/register: Wednesday, Jan 16th, 7 PM-8:30 PM/ Place will be announced at convention

\*Designs must be in place by 11 am Thursday, Jan 17th, for judging. The decision of the judges is final.

\*Dismantle Design Show Saturday 9am AND set up for the Banquet tables and floral designs.

**1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded, if merited in each class.**

**\*Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion ribbons will be awarded for the two best designs of the show.**

### NOTES:

- **Plan to register** and sign up for your specific class entries on the night prior to the show. This advance registration allows the show committee to plan for adequate space.
- Basic containers, gladiolus and other flower materials will be available for designers on registration day.
- **IF YOU are the 1<sup>st</sup> person to place your arrangement in the appropriate class, PLACE it to the FAR LEFT** on the table. **Each designer after that** will then, add their arrangement as close to the previous arrangement. Make sure your arrangement **does not obstruct** any other design for the judges. **Doing this will cause minimal movement of completed arrangements prior to judging.**
- Please return unused containers and oasis.
